Note from Jennifer Burch - Healing Journey Ministry

As we approach the national observance of Sanctity of Life Sunday, I am led to remind our fellowship of Fairway's ministry, Healing Journey. Annually, on the third Sunday in January, many churches nationwide declare human life begins at conception. Isaiah 49:1, Psalm 139:13-16

Fairway Christian Church's ministry, Healing Journey, helps those of us who have been affected by making or being related to one who has made the irreversible decision to terminate a pregnancy. Through this ministry, I help others to acknowledge and work through the heartbreak, guilt, anger, and even regret that lingers.

I work with small groups and/or one on one. The goal is to create a safe environment for experiencing Biblical guidance and application through love, compassion and understanding. Your heartbreak could be from your own decision or from the loss of a grandchild or a niece/nephew. Whatever your burden, I invite you to consider tapping into this ministry, Healing Journey. I use an excellent Bible study written by Linda Cochrane, Forgiven and Set Free, to guide our discussions and lead us through a process of healing.
