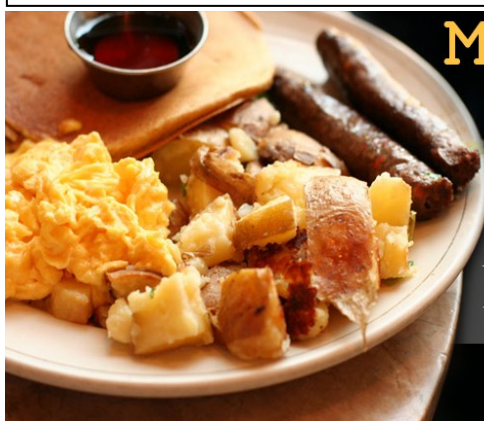

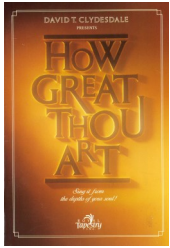

# ELDERS

Elder Meeting Minutes  
February 17, 2025

The February Elder's meeting was called to order with the following elders present: Harry Harris, Fred Holland, Paul Cook, Jerry Benware and Roger Brown. Presenters attending: Church Administrator, Chris Callahan and Chairman of the Deacons, Michael Bolter.

Fred presented the opening meditation and prayer.

The January minutes were accepted and approved.

Michael presented the Deacon's report. The teaching portion of the meetings for the next several months will be the Restoration Movement. Chris gave the deacons an update on the construction process. It was highlighted that Tom Ross gave an update on the Emergency Response team and that Gerald and the parking lot team still need more volunteer assistance. Michael shared that the Women's Ministry events are covered through June. Michael shared that the Saturday night service deacon representatives appreciated that special programs and events would be scheduled in such a way as not to disrupt the Saturday night service. An appreciation dinner for the Deacons and their wives is scheduled for Friday, February 28th.

Chris presented the Administrative report. The January financial report was approved. Chris also provided a review of the year-end reports and answered detailed administrative questions. He noted that the FORWARD Campaign update was presented to the congregation over the weekend by Paul and Roger. He noted that an informal question-and-answer meeting is scheduled for the following Thursday night in the Fellowship Hall for anyone having follow-up questions. Chris noted that of the FORWARD pledges scheduled to be completed, \$449,000 remains to be donated. Chris mentioned that construction progress in the near future may compel us to reschedule or cancel some events that may be hampered by the destruction of some existing walls and utilities. The contractor still appears to be on schedule and within cost. Chris reminded everyone that updates are available on the church website.

The monthly ministers' written reports, to include the Preaching Minister's Report and each of the Associate Ministers' reports, were provided for elder review. Butch attended the Christian Restoration Association and spoke in the conference's closing session. He noted that Dr. McMurtry completed his seminar with exciting presentations on marriage and Noah's Flood. Butch also highlighted continued Elder/Ministry staff meetings to share and develop strategies for reaching new ministry opportunities around us (Assisted Living facilities, family neighborhoods, etc.). A new four-week First Step seminar started in early February with twenty-seven new or potential members attending. We had seventy-eight members respond to support opportunities for the opening service of our church plant, Unity Christian Church. A follow-up planning meeting has been scheduled. The Choir is working on the Easter Musical "How Great Thou Art," which will be presented on Friday, April 11 and Sunday, April 13, both at 6:00 PM. Bible study opportunities are in full swing for men, women, and combined classes throughout the week. Many wellness visits and assistance visits, as well as care facility events, are ongoing, which are characteristic of the loving and active nature of our church.

Under Old Business, several church policies and procedures are in the process of final update. In addition, a new policy and associated certification documents are being developed to support an annual certification of qualification for elders, deacons and ministry leaders. The bimonthly Elders and Ministers meeting held last month resulted in several actions being assigned to refine and clarify our church's position on several "What We Believe" statements.

Under New Business, Paul shared that Mike Czerwonky expressed a desire to complete his position of service as Chairman of the Missions Committee. The missions committee nominated Mary Cook as the new Chairperson for the committee requesting elder approval. The elders approved Mary to be the new Chairperson. Mike committed to serve as Chairman Emeritus through this year to ensure continuity for the committee. He will continue to serve as a committee member as he completes this commitment.

The meeting was closed in prayer by Paul.

The next monthly Elders meeting is scheduled for March 20, 2025.

# DEACONS

## Emergency Response Team

Fairway is where we come to worship, give thanks and fellowship. But even in church emergencies do and have happened. Medical and health incidents from minor scrapes to allergic reactions, trips and falls or breathing problems remain a risk for all of us. Having a dedicated team ready to respond can make all the difference.

The Senior Health & Wellness Ministry works to prepare Fairway to respond to emergencies during worship services. The role of the Emergency Response Team includes summoning help, directing a response, and providing aid until an ambulance arrives. The ERT works to ensure the safety of everyone within the church, and to coordinate with medical professionals.

If you possess a compassionate heart there's a place for you on the Emergency Response Team. Medical experience is not necessary, you will receive training. Becoming part of the Emergency Response Team is not only crucial, it's a profound act of service and love. Your participation ensures that Fairway remains well-prepared in the face of emergencies.
